### **EDDIE DINSHAW SCHOLARSHIPS**

The College proposes to elect one or more Dinshaw scholars among students who have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2012-2013. The Scholarships are open only to candidates of Indian nationality reading for degrees in engineering, mathematics, economics, history, law, and the physical and biological sciences. (This includes biochemistry but excludes integrated immunology and the DPhil in psychiatry).

The Scholarships may be awarded in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, or other award or scholarship, or may be awarded separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to UK Research Council maintenance rates for the duration of the Scholar's course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January, and must apply for any University scholarship for which they are eligible.

The Scholarships will normally be awarded to applicants to Balliol (including those who have expressed no college preference but are considered first by Balliol).
