



## **EDDIE DINSHAW SCHOLARSHIP**

The College seeks to elect a Dinshaw Scholar. The Scholarship is open only to candidates of Indian nationality reading for any postgraduate degree in Engineering, Mathematics, Economics, History, Law or Physical and Biological Sciences. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for one of these courses in the academic year 2018/19.

The Scholarship may be offered in conjunction with the University Clarendon Fund Award, or may be offered separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be no more than £10,000.

The award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant January deadline. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
