FOLEY-BEJAR SCHOLARSHIPS

The College seeks to elect a number of Foley-Béjar scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2012-2013. The scholarships are open only to candidates who were born in or who have one parent born in Mexico, Spain, or the Republic of Ireland, or who have a strong connection with Northern Ireland. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholars read.

The Scholarships may be awarded in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, or a UK Research Council award, or may be awarded separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund or a UK Research Council, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to UK Research Council maintenance rates for the duration of the Scholar's course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January, and must apply for any University scholarship for which they are eligible.

Candidates who wish to be considered on the basis of a parent's nationality or because they have a strong link to Northern Ireland must inform the Balliol College Admissions office of this as soon as they learn they have an offer of a place from Oxford University.

The Scholarships will normally be awarded to applicants to Balliol (including those who have expressed no college preference but are considered first by Balliol).
