THE HAKEEM BELO-OSAGIE SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect a Hakeem Belo-Osagie Scholar who has an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2012-2013. The scholarship is open to citizens of any African country. There are no special restrictions as to the Scholar's degree or subject.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, another University or other award, or may be awarded separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and may also provide an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £9,000 per year for the duration of the Scholar's course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January, and must apply for any University scholarship, including the Clarendon, for which they are eligible.

The Scholarship will normally be awarded to an applicant to Balliol (including those who have expressed no college preference but are considered first by Balliol).
