THE IKOS HALF-BURSARIES

Balliol College is pleased to invite applications for the **IKOS Half-Bursaries**.

The College seeks to award two IKOS half-bursaries to candidates who have gained an offer of admission to read for a higher degree at Balliol College from October 2012. The recipients should have expressed an intention to pursue an academic, vocational or public-service oriented career following their degrees.

The awards will normally be tenable for the duration of the recipient's degree course, up to a maximum of four years, subject to satisfactory academic performance. The awards each provide a grant of £6,000 per annum for living expenses. They may be offered in conjunction with an award from the University's Clarendon Fund or from a UK Research Council.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission by the University's second deadline in January, and must apply for any University scholarship, including the Clarendon, for which they are eligible.

The Scholarships will normally be awarded to applicants to Balliol (including those who have expressed no college preference but are considered first by Balliol).
