### **THE JASON HU SCHOLARSHIPS**

The College seeks to elect five Jason Hu Scholars who have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2012-2013. Four of the scholarships are open only to candidates who are citizens of Taiwan or of China as a whole. One of the scholarships is open to candidates from any country in Asia. There are no subject restrictions on the scholarships.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, another University or other award, or may be awarded separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and may also provide an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £10,000 per year for the duration of the Scholar's course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January, and must apply for any University scholarship, including the Clarendon, for which they are eligible.

The Scholarship will normally be awarded to an applicant to Balliol (including those who have expressed no college preference but are considered first by Balliol).
