



JOHN HENRY JONES SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect up to two John Henry Jones Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a DPhil commencing in the academic year 2018/19. The scholarships are open to candidates in any subject in the Humanities Division except Philosophy, any subject in Maths, Physical and Life Sciences Division except for Chemistry or Politics/International Relations.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, or may be offered separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses.

In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £10,000 per annum for a maximum of four years. Under these circumstances, preference will be given to those with partial funding from other sources for whom this would create a full funding package.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
