THE GREGORY KULKES SCHOLARSHIPS IN LAW

The College seeks to elect as Gregory Kulkes scholars one or more students who have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree in Law commencing in the academic year 2012-2013.

One scholarship will be awarded in conjunction with a UK Research Council Award. Further awards may be available in conjunction with another award, or may be awarded separately. Awards are of variable amounts usually up to about £2,500 per annum for the duration of the scholar's degree, subject to satisfactory academic progress. The award made in conjunction with the UK Research Council will make a combined award covering full fees and a maintenance stipend.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January, and must apply for any UK Research Council award or other University Scholarship for which they are eligible.

The Scholarships will normally be awarded to applicants to Balliol (including those who have expressed no college preference but are considered first by Balliol).
