



## THE SIMON LINNETT SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect as a Simon Linnett Scholar a student who has an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a DPhil in Economics, writing on a topic in environmental economics, commencing in the academic year 2018/19.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a with a UK Research Council award, or may be offered separately. When awarded jointly with a UK Research Council award, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be £6,000 per annum.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
