



THE McDUGALL SCHOLARSHIP IN LAW

The College seeks to elect a McDougall Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree in Law commencing in the academic year 2018/19.

The Scholarship may be offered in conjunction with a UK Research Council award, or it may be awarded separately. When awarded jointly with a UK Research Council, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees, and a grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £7,250 per annum.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
