



THE OXFORD ECONOMICS SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect an *Oxford Economics* Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for the Master of Philosophy in Economics commencing in the academic year 2018/19, with the intention of pursuing the DPhil in Economics immediately following completion of the two-year MPhil programme. Progression from the MPhil to the DPhil is not automatic and will require an application to be made to the DPhil programme during the second year of the MPhil.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with an ESRC Studentship or it may be offered separately. When awarded jointly, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees, and a grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be £4,000 per annum for the duration of the Scholar's course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made. Provided the subsequent application to the DPhil is successful, the funding will continue, with a maximum duration of funding for 4 years in total.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to the MPhil in Economics by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for these awards.
