Balliol College is pleased to invite applications for the Snell Scholarship and Snell Exhibition for 2012–13.

The College seeks to elect one Scholar and one or more Exhibitioners who have gained an offer of admission to read for a higher degree at Balliol College from October 2012 after completing a degree at the University of Glasgow. Applications are invited from good Honours graduates of the University of Glasgow, or from students in their final Honours year at the University of Glasgow who hope to graduate with a first or good upper second class degree.

The awards are normally tenable for the duration of the award holder's course, depending on satisfactory academic progress and the duration of the degree programme followed. The value of the Scholarship is normally £8,000 per annum and the Exhibition is normally £2,500 per annum. All applicants who are eligible must also apply for an SAAS or Research Council Award and any other Oxford University Scholarships for which they are eligible.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January, and must apply for any University scholarship for which they are eligible.

Only graduates of the University of Glasgow are eligible.

The Scholarships will normally be awarded to applicants to Balliol (including those who have expressed no college preference but are considered first by Balliol).
