



THE DAN NORMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect a Dan Norman Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a Doctor of Philosophy degree (DPhil) commencing in the academic year 2023/24. The Scholarship is open only to candidates who are conducting scientific research (either directly or indirectly) relating to addiction within one of the following disciplines: biochemistry, biological sciences (Interdisciplinary), clinical medicine, clinical neurosciences, experimental psychology, medical sciences, neuroscience, pathology, pharmacology, physiology, anatomy and genetics, primary healthcare sciences, psychiatry, and zoology.

The Scholarship is intended to be awarded in conjunction with a [UK Research Council](#) award but could be offered separately. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £15,500 per annum, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Balliol College

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
