



JOHN HENRY JONES SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect up to two John Henry Jones Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University to read for a DPhil commencing in the academic year 2024/25. For 2024/25 admissions, the scholarships are open to candidates in any subject in the Social Sciences or MPLS Divisions.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a [University Clarendon Fund Award](#). In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £10,000 per annum for the duration of fee liability. Under these circumstances, preference will be given to those with partial funding from other sources for whom this would create a full funding package.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see <https://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/graduate/fees-and-funding/oxford-funding>). No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
