



## THE JOWETT SCHOLARSHIPS

The College seeks to elect up to two Jowett Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2024/25. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholar reads, although a preference may be shown for subjects not covered by other subject-restricted Balliol scholarships (current Balliol subject specific scholarships: Classics, Economics, History, Law).

The Scholarships may be offered in conjunction with a [University Clarendon Fund Award](#) or a [UK Research Council Award](#). In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship(s) may be awarded separately. If the awarded alone, its value will be up to £9,000 per annum.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see <https://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/graduate/fees-and-funding/oxford-funding>). No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
