



THE BALLIOL-OXFORD ECONOMICS SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect a *Balliol-Oxford Economics* Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a research degree in Economics in the academic year 2024/25. Applications must demonstrate particular interest in contemporary macroeconomic policy in its international context.

The Scholarship will be awarded jointly with the Department of Economics. The Scholarship covers all University and College fees, and a grant for living expenses equal to the value of the UKRI stipend for the first two years of the scholarship. In the third year, the scholarship will cover all University and College fees (or continuation fees if outside fee liability), a reduced stipend and a guaranteed graduate teaching assistantship (GTA)*, the total of these two will equal a stipend at UKRI levels. The maximum length of the scholarship will be 3 years.

*GTA - the teaching load of a graduate teaching assistant is four contact hours per week during term time. The student will need to apply for a GTA when announced by the Department so that teaching preferences can be taken into account for teaching allocation. The scholarship holder will be guaranteed a GTA

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see <https://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/graduate/fees-and-funding/oxford-funding>). No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
