



## THE BALLIOL SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect up to two Balliol Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2024/25. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholar reads, but subjects that are not covered by other subject-restricted Balliol scholarships may be preferred (current Balliol subject specific scholarships: Classics, Economics, History, Law).

The value of this scholarship will be £4,000 per annum.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see <https://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/graduate/fees-and-funding/oxford-funding>). No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
