



ARTHUR JAMES RICHMOND PATON SCHOLARSHIP IN LAW

The College seeks to elect an Arthur James Richmond Paton Law Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree in Law commencing in the academic year 2024/25. The scholarship is open only to candidates who have previously completed a degree at Balliol College.

The Scholarships may be awarded in conjunction with a University or Faculty award or it may be offered separately. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be £4,000 per annum.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see <https://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/graduate/fees-and-funding/oxford-funding>). No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
