



## THE DERVORGUILLA SCHOLARSHIPS

The College seeks to elect up to three female students to be Dervorguilla Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2024/25. The scholarships for 2024/25 are open to candidates in the Medical Sciences, MPLS or Social Sciences divisions.

The Scholarships may be awarded in conjunction with [UK Research Council](#) scholarships or other University awards, such as a Leverhulme Trust or Wolfson Foundation doctoral scholarships. In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be £4,500.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see <https://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/graduate/fees-and-funding/oxford-funding>). No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
