



THE ALFRED DOUGLAS STONE AWARD

The College seeks to elect a Stone Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2026/27. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholar reads, although a preference may be shown for subjects not covered by other subject-restricted Balliol scholarships (current Balliol subject specific scholarships: Law, MFL, Physics, History, Philosophy, Classics).

The Scholarship may be offered in conjunction with a [University Clarendon Fund](#) award. In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £21,383 per annum.

This award is made for up to three years, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see [Oxford funding | University of Oxford](#)).

No separate application is required for this award, if you are eligible then you will be considered as part of your main university application.
