



EDDIE DINSHAW SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect an Eddie Dinshaw Scholar. The Scholarship is open only to candidates of Indian nationality reading for any higher degree in Engineering, Mathematics, Economics, History, Law or Physical and Biological Sciences. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for one of these courses in the academic year 2026/27.

The Scholarships may be awarded in conjunction with [UK Research Council](#) scholarships or other University awards. In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £10,250 per annum.

This award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see [Oxford funding | University of Oxford](#)).

No separate application is required for this award, if you are eligible then you will be considered as part of your main university application.
