



THE J T HAMILTON SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect a J T Hamilton Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree in Physics commencing in the academic year 2026/27.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a [UK Research Council](#) scholarship or other University award. In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to UKRI stipend per annum for the duration of fee liability.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see [Oxford funding | University of Oxford](#)).

No separate application is required for this award, if you are eligible then you will be considered as part of your main university application.
