



THE JASON HU SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect a Jason Hu Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2026/27. The scholarship is open only to candidates who are citizens of Taiwan, China or to candidates to Asia as a whole. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholar reads.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with [UK Research Council](#) scholarships or other University awards. In exceptional circumstances, the scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If awarded alone, its value will be up to £10,250 per annum.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see [Oxford funding | University of Oxford](#)).

No separate application is required for this award, if you are eligible then you will be considered as part of your main university application.
