



JOHN HENRY JONES SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect up to two John Henry Jones Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University to read for a DPhil commencing in the academic year 2026/27. For 2026/27 admissions, the scholarships are open to candidates subjects in the Social Sciences, MPLS or MSD Divisions.

The Scholarships may be awarded in conjunction with a [University Clarendon Fund Award](#), a [UK Research Council](#) scholarship or other University award. In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarships may be made as a stand-alone award. If a Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to UKRI stipend per annum.

Awards are made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see [Oxford funding | University of Oxford](#)).

No separate application is required for this award, if you are eligible then you will be considered as part of your main university application.
