



THE MARVIN BOWER SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect a Marvin Bower Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree in International Relations, Management or Business Studies (excluding the MBA), Economics, or Mathematics, commencing in the academic year 2026/27.

The Scholarship may be offered in conjunction with a [University Clarendon Fund](#) award, UK Research Council award or other University awards. In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be UKRI stipend per annum.

The award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see [Funding | University of Oxford](#)). No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
