



THE SNELL EXHIBITION

The College seeks to elect one Snell Exhibitioner. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2026/27, having already completed a degree at the University of Glasgow. Applications are invited from good Honours graduates of the University of Glasgow, or from students in their final Honours year at the University of Glasgow who hope to graduate with a first or good upper second class degree in MPLS, Social Sciences and Medical Sciences.

The Exhibition may be offered in conjunction with a [UK Research Council](#) award or other University award. In exceptional circumstances, the Exhibition may be made as a stand-alone award. If the Exhibition is awarded alone, its value will be £5,400 per annum.

This award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the relevant course scholarship deadline (see [Oxford funding | University of Oxford](#)).

No separate application is required for this award, if you are eligible then you will be considered as part of your main university application.
