



THE JASON HU SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect up to two Jason Hu Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2017-2018. The Scholarship is open only to candidates who are citizens of Taiwan or of China as a whole. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholar reads.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, or may be offered separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to the value of the Clarendon stipend (at least £14,296 in 2017/2018) per annum for the duration of the Scholar's course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
