



THE JASON HU SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect up to two Jason Hu Scholars. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2018/19. One of the scholarships is open to candidates from any country in Asia, but one is open only to candidates who are citizens of Taiwan or China as a whole. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholar reads.

The Scholarship may be awarded in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, or may be offered separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to the value of the Clarendon stipend (no less than £14,553 per annum).

The award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
