



## THE SINGAPORE LAW SCHOLARSHIP

The College seeks to elect a Singapore Law Scholar. Candidates will be of Singaporean citizenship and will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a degree in Law commencing in the academic year 2018/19.

The Scholarship may be offered in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, or it may be awarded separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees and an additional grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £10,000 per annum.

This award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a degree in Law by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
