



THE ALFRED DOUGLAS STONE AWARD

The College seeks to elect a Stone Scholar. Candidates will have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Balliol College to read for a higher degree commencing in the academic year 2018/19. There are no special restrictions as to the subject or degree for which the Scholar reads, although a preference may be shown for subjects not covered by other subject-restricted Balliol scholarships.

The Scholarship may be offered in conjunction with a University Clarendon Fund Award, or may be awarded separately. When awarded jointly with the Clarendon Fund, the Scholarship covers all University and College fees, and a grant for living expenses. If the Scholarship is awarded alone, its value will be up to £7,250 per annum.

This award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and is tenable only at Balliol College.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to a higher degree by the University's second deadline in January. No separate application is required to be considered for this award.
